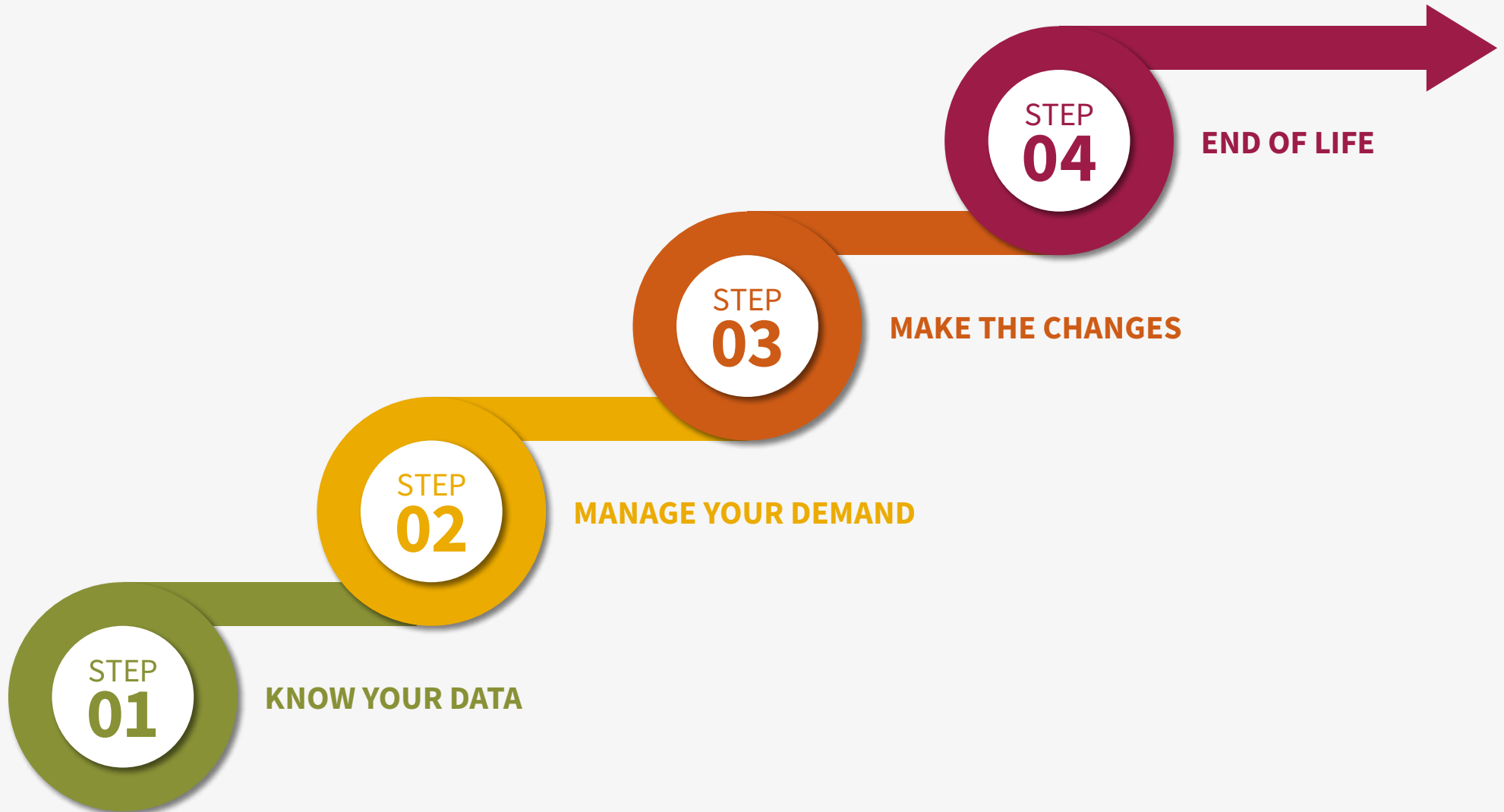

Multifunctional Devices, Managed Print and Content Services and Records and Information Management
