



A step by step guide on how to access and use the RM6261 MVDS Price Comparison Tool

Important Notice

Please ensure that you read and understand the following points before seeking to use the Price Comparison Tool:

- It is a commercially sensitive document and therefore must <u>not</u> be shared outside of your organisation once downloaded from the eMarketplace.
- Please ensure that you download the most recent version of the tool before completing your pricing evaluation. You will be able to check this by comparing the version number of your current download against the version number on the eMarketplace.
- Pricing within the tool is provided on the basis of a 24 month minimum contract. If you wish to contract the rates provided for less than 24 months please speak with the Lot 1 suppliers to confirm that they are in agreement.


Signing up to the eMarketplace

Before you are able to access the eMarketplace you must ensure that your organisation is registered and that you have been given your login details.

To register for the eMarketplace please click the link <u>here</u> and fill out the form on the webpage.

Once you are registered and have your login details, go to the <u>login page</u> to access the eMarketplace.

Once you have logged in, select the "shopping" tab at the top of your webpage - please make sure you are also viewing the "marketplace" sub-tab within this.



The layout of your search page may vary to what is shown within the previous page, however you should still have a "search for items and services" search bar available.

Please search for "RM6261".

Once you have clicked "search" you will be taken to the marketplace items. This will include:

- The MVDS Price Comparison Tool,
- individual supplier Quality Evaluation Documents,
- and any individual supplier Optional Services.

Desktop Evaluation

In order to conduct your desktop evaluation you must decide how it will be assessed against your statement of requirements. To complete this the buyer should assess the Price Comparison Tool and Quality Evaluation Documents against the evaluating criteria and weighting shown in the table on this page.

You should apply the Direct Award Criteria only to the Catalogue of the suppliers capable of meeting the required standard and your requirements.

Evaluation criteria	Weighting
Quality	Between 40% and 90%
Price	Between 10% and 60%

To set out your quality criteria please consider the examples below:

- approach to delivery of the services/methodology, including the strategies, expertise, methods, materials, and procedures in the proposal.
- technical merit, including the competence, skills, and experience of the management, professional, and technical personnel proposed for the project.
- ways of working, including the proposed management systems and methods, project management tools, software, touchpoints, etc.
- social value (in-scope organisations need to consider PPN 06/20 which should account for a minimum of 10%).

When to apply Quality Evaluation Documents and Optional Services

Quality Evaluation Documents

The Quality Evaluation Documents are to be downloaded and reviewed as part of the desktop evaluation and should be used to inform the weighted scoring.

Documents included are as follows:

- •The suppliers' service description
- Quality responses for your quality evaluation
- The optional service rate card provided at framework level
- The suppliers' device catalogue as a pdf or as a link to their website
- and the supplier's prospectus which is an information only document

Optional Services


Optional Services are available as enhancements to your core voice and data requirements. For example, this may include but is not limited to:

- Mobile Device Management
- International Roaming
- Technology Funds

While you are able to include these offerings within your Call-Off Contract it is important to note that they were not evaluated at framework level and therefore cannot be included as part of your desktop evaluation.

Your search results will appear as shown.


To access the documents please click on the blue hyperlink titles - eg, RM6261 MVDS Price Comparison Tool.



When selected, you will be redirected to the item page containing "external links" on the left side of the screen.

To access the tool please select the link referencing the Price Comparison Tool and its latest version number.

Once selected and automated downloaded of the Price Comparison Tool will commence. This will be stored as an Excel document within your usual download location.





Navigating the Price Comparison Tool (PCT)

Upon opening the Excel document you will notice seven tabs along the bottom, each serving their own function.



Disclaimer: Please ensure that you read this in full before using the tool.

Instructions: This tab provides you with guidance on how to complete the tool, as well as additional advice.

Buyer Input Sheet: You will input your existing estate and upcoming contract requirements here.

Suppliers Price Comparison: Provides a side by side view of each suppliers rate card based on your requirement.


Pricing Dashboard: Evaluation result based on your requirement with useful tables indicating savings.

Navigating the Price Comparison Tool - Buyer Input Sheet

This section of the input sheet is generally self-explanatory.

Follow the prompts to input your existing estate information (boxes 1 and 2), followed by your future estate needs (boxes 3 and 4).

As mentioned previously, pricing for the tool was provided on a minimum 24 month basis.



As you input your requirement you will notice that your banding may automatically change.


different tariff charges based on the volume of connections which is divided into 8 bands.

Each supplier may have

- Band 1 1-499
- Band 2 500-999
- Band 3 1000-1999
- Band 4 2000-4999
- Band 5 5000-9999
- Band 6 10,000-19,999
- Band 7 20,000-39,999
- Band 8 40,000+

Navigating the Price Comparison Tool - Buyer Input Sheet

The two sections pictured are where you input your data requirement for your new contract.



Input a "1" into the yellow box corresponding to the shared data bolt-on required for your estate.

Note: you may only select one option. It is therefore recommended that if you are unsure of your data usage, select the higher bolt-on as this can be reduced during the lifetime of your contract.

Single data means each connection has their own dedicated data allowance as opposed to shared data, that allows multiple SIMs to draw from a single, shared pool of data.

Single data can help with managing the consumption by individual users, capping etc, but often works out more expensive than a shared data pool. Shared data pools allow high users to consume more to balance out low users, reducing the risk of out-of-bundle charges.

Navigating the Price Comparison Tool - Buyer Input Sheet

The Pay-as-You-Consume section of the Price Comparison Tool is optional and not necessary for many buyers to complete. The reason for this is that an All Inclusive tariff for example, means you won't have to pay-as-you-consume food domestic calls, and if a buyer was to roam they should be subject to the terms of the supplier's roaming package.

Nonetheless, this section can on entry of usage data, provide an indicative idea of what a future year will cost for volumes not covered under All-inclusive Voice/SMS Tariffs orr any international roaming packages.

Navigating the Price Comparison Tool - Suppliers Price Comparison

Once you have selected your data requirement within the Buyer Input Sheet the comparison table will identify the annual rates for each supplier.

For awareness, there annual rates will only show against your chosen data tariff, however the unit costs will always show against each tariff.

We advise copying this table (using the tariffs of your winning supplier only) when completing your Call-Off Contract in preparation for if/when you require flexing up or down your tariff.
