

## Knowledge Hub

Knowledge Hub is a cross-government knowledge sharing platform, designed to help colleagues across departments connect with each other and share knowledge, insights and best practice. The Government Commercial Function (GCF) set up a group on Knowledge Hub in February 2017, with the aim of 'creating one commercial community'.

## Joining the Community of Practice

1. Go to <https://khub.net/>
2. Sign in (using a google account is easiest) or set up a login
3. Go to 'my profile' at the top right hand corner and update your details
4. Click on the 'Networks' tab on the top grey bar, scroll down and you will see 'Government Commercial Function' - you will have to request to join which usually takes a couple of hours to approve
5. In the 'Government Commercial Function' network, scroll across to the 'join groups' panel on the right hand side and select 'Buying Digital Community'. The team will then approve your access and you will be part of the group.

The KHub Community of Practice group is used to help members network, keep the conversation going in between meet ups, capture user feedback for the Digital Marketplace, share presentations and publicise upcoming events.
