Supply and Fit of Tyres and Associated Services

Customer guidance notes RM3767



Agreement start date: 11 October 2016
Agreement expiry date: 10 October 2020

Background

The previous Crown Commercial Service pan-government supply and fit of tyres framework agreement (RM955) expired on 10 October 2016.

Following consultation with key stakeholders the need for a single replacement framework agreement was identified which would offer a full range of tyres and associated fitting services to organisations across the public sector.

Lots

- **Lot 1:** the supply and fit of tyres and associated services for blue light emergency services throughout the UK. Includes tyres for cars, on road 4x4s, 4x4s (with off road capability), vans, light commercial vehicles (LCVs), heavy goods vehicles (HGVs) and heavy commercial vehicles (HCVs) over 3.5 tonnes, coaches, buses and minibuses, agrarian vehicles and motorised/non motorised bicycles.
- **Lot 2:** the supply and fit of tyres and associated services for all government and public sector organisations throughout the UK. Includes tyres for cars, on road 4x4s, 4x4s (with off road capability), vans, light commercial vehicles (LCVs), heavy goods vehicles (HGVs) and heavy commercial vehicles (HCVs) over 3.5 tonnes, coaches, buses and minibuses, agrarian vehicles and motorised/non motorised bicycles and Luton box vans with tail lift (often required for off road use for military exercises).

The following items are also available under the framework agreement:

- a. emergency breakdown service
- b. tyre disposal
- c. tyre hotel facility
- d. standard fitting
- e. wheel valve
- f. wheel balance
- g. calibration and adjustment of tracking
- h. wheel and axle alignment checks
- i. repair of punctured tyres
- j. turn on the rim and twinning
- k. high pressure valve caps
- l. valve extensions
- m. re-tread and re-groove
- n. tyron bands

Benefits of using the framework agreement

- aggregated volumes from across the public sector allowing for consistently lower pricing
- stakeholder input from police, ambulance trusts, local government and central government departments that shaped the requirement and contributed to the supplier selection and tender evaluation

- various supply options including fit at supplier depot, supplier fit at customer premises and roadside fitting
- comprehensive range of tyres and associated services offered under the framework agreement
- pre-negotiated terms and conditions
- opportunity for further reduced pricing via further competition under lot 2

How the framework works

Call-off contracts for goods may be awarded by direct award i.e. without re-opening competition or by further competition.

Call-off contracts, whether as a result of direct award or following a further competition, will be formed by the issue of an order by the customer to the supplier and acceptance by the supplier of such an order.
