

Why G-Cloud?

- A competitive marketplace for huge range of cloud solutions
- Framework's re-procured every 12 months to keep services fresh
- Cloud First, Government determined to be as efficient as possible
- A catalogue of commoditised, cloud based services
- Fast procurement process



G-Cloud Background

- Over 4,000 suppliers
- Nearly 30,000 services
- Nearly 90% of the suppliers are SME's
- £5.7 billion spend on G-Cloud since 2012
- Over 40% of spend goes to SME's
- In 2019 1467 suppliers reported spend

Find technology or people for digital projects in the public sector

Find an individual specialist

eg a developer or user researcher.

eg a booking system or accessibility audit

eg people from a specific user group to test your service

Find a user research tab

eg a room to conduct research sessions

Find cloud hosting, software and support

eg content delivery networks or accounting software

Buy physical datacentre space

eg access to mission-critical datacentres

Sell services

Monthly MI Reporting

- All suppliers must submit a monthly MI return regardless whether there is any business to report
- Information must be reported every month during the framework period and thereafter until all call-off contracts have expired. This will include orders received and invoices raised for the period.
- Extremely important information to us as it enables us to capture accurate spend and savings that we must report to Government.

What's Changing for G-Cloud 12

Standardising and improving quality of information on Digital Marketplace and simplifying the application process....

- Service definition documents are now mandatory
- Digital signing process for applications
- Must have a valid Duns number to apply
- Otherwise a 'cut & paste' of G-Cloud 11



What services can you sell through G-Cloud 12?

- Cloud Hosting
 Covers Infrastructure and Platform as a Service for example a computer server or storage in the cloud
- Cloud Software

 Is an application or service that can be run over the internet or cloud for example accounting tools or customer service management software
- Cloud Support
 Support your transition to laaS, PaaS and SaaS for example migration to the cloud, configuration/implementation of services from Lots 1 & 2

What's in / out of scope?

Out of scope:

- Co-location services (CoLo)
- Non-cloud related services / consultancy
- Stand-alone bespoke design and development
- Hardware
- Recruitment only consultancy relating to the cloud is permitted, not the provision of staff or interims



Application Process Hints

- Think about your wording of the short description what are buyers searching for ?
- Ensure pricing is clear no P.O.A or links to pricing
- Service definition documents are now mandetory
- Put yourselves in the mind of the buyer with service descriptions
- Ask clarification questions early especially legal ones
- Leave plenty of time to complete submissions be aware of the dates!



Do's and Don'ts....

Do

- Ask clarification questions early and check the clarification log, as your question may have already been answered
- Start your application as early as possible

Don't

- Leave submissions until the last minute
- Don't upload out of scope services
 - Non-cloud related services / consultancy
 - Stand-alone bespoke design and development



Application process

Applications via Digital Marketplace

Suppliers need to be registered to the Digital Marketplace

Check you can access Digital Marketplace via your logon in advance

Enter company details, complete 'supplier declaration', enter details of services

There is the facility to copy services from G-Cloud 11 to 12

Note: Use supplier portal to ask clarification questions
